ALUMNI OVERVIEW

After participating in a Youth Leadership Corps program of the Philadelphia Outward Bound School, alumni will be selected to continue discovering and refining their leadership potential. POBS offers a year-long Apprentice Program, during which apprentices will play a pivotal role in selecting and developing next year's YLC students and model Outward Bound's core value of service by engaging in positive ways with their schools and communities.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve as an advocate for participating students.
- Assist in the recruiting efforts and student selection process for YLC.
- Be the primary coordinator for each crew's post expedition service project and YLC alumni meet ups.
- Attend the summer YLC expedition as an Instructor assistant and role model.
- Assist POBS Program Team in outreach and preparation for enrolling students.

REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS

- NJ or PHL Youth Leadership Corps Alum.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Desire to give back to your community through service.
- Background screenings (costs covered by POBS).

APPRENTICE PROGRAM 2018 TIMELINE

December 2018: Application Selection

POBS will take the time to outline the goals and vision for your apprenticeship and help you build a leadership development plan for the program.

January – February 2018: Recruitment

Assist POBS team in student recruitment and school/community outreach (distributing flyers, making presentations, and sharing your experience with interested students) .

March 2018: Interview / Selection of Students

Help POBS team interview and select YLC candidates - do they have what it takes to be part of the Youth Leadership Corps?

July – August 2018: Training and 2018 Expedition

NJ YLC: 7/8/18 – 7/21/18

PHL YLC: 7/23/18 – 8/5/18

POBS will provide specialized training to prepare you for your role on the expedition course. You will be part of the Instructor team and help facilitate a YLC expedition crew as an Instructor assistant.

August – September 2018: Service Project

Post-expedition, you will help your YLC crew coordinate a meaningful service project that impacts your community.

October 2018: Annual Fundraiser

Help raise money for Youth Leadership Corps and get the chance to participate in this annual fundraising event!

November 2018: Alumni Celebration and Gathering

Work with POBS team to bring your crew together to celebrate their service and engage their families and community in a special event.

December 2016: Completion of Apprenticeship Program and Inauguration to YLC Committee

Recognition of your service to the POBS YLC program and inauguration into an elite leadership team as a member of the YLC Committee. In this role, you will help us continue to select YLC alumni Apprentices and improve this unique program that inspires youth leaders to make their world a better place
